*The first time that the name “School of Business Administration” appeared in a commencement program was June **1957**.

*The following is from the minutes of the Board of Directors, 05/23/1958:

“The title of the School of Business Administration was next discussed. Although this division of the University has been called a school for the past year, it was discovered that the Board of Directors had never officially acted on the change from a division to a school. Hence Father Fadner moved and Father Collins seconded the motion that this part of the University be known as the School of Business Administration. The motion was passed unanimously.”
