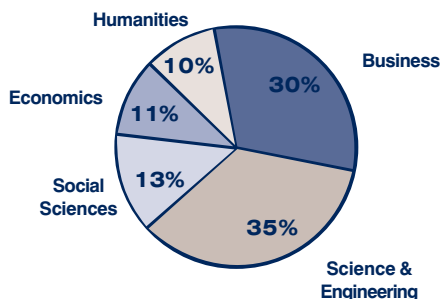

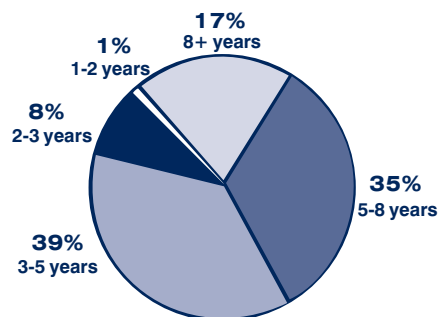

The average number of years of work experience for the class is 5 years 7 months.

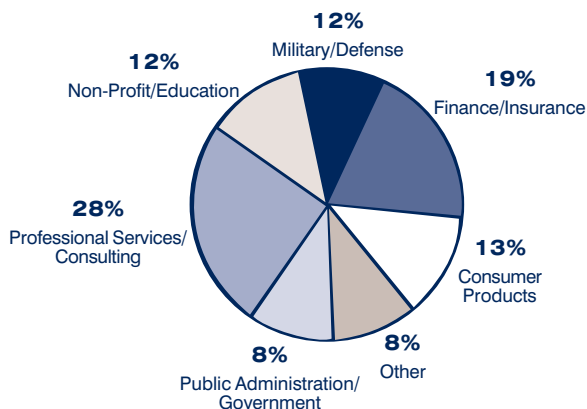

### Application Prerequisites:

Georgetown University seeks a diverse student body and encourages applications from students with a wide variety of academic and professional backgrounds. To be considered for admission, you must:

- Hold a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in the United States or the equivalent from an international college or university.
- Submit official results from the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT), Georgetown MBA Evening Program Code JT7-G0-64.
- Submit official results from the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) if you are an international student whose undergraduate degree was in a language other than English.
- Submit two professional recommendations.
- Submit official transcripts of all academic coursework and certified translations where applicable.
- Have a minimum of three years of professional work experience to be most competitive in the admission process.

### Application Options:

Applications to our program must be submitted online by visiting <http://www.mba.georgetown.edu>. After submitting your online application, all of your supplemental materials should be collected and mailed to our office.

### Application Fees:

Our \$175 application fee is non-refundable and must be received before your application will be considered.

### Interviews:

Interviews will be conducted at the invitation of the Admissions Committee only. If you are selected for an interview, you will be contacted via e-mail or telephone.

### Information Sessions:

We encourage all applicants to attend an on-campus information session. Please visit our website to see when the next available sessions are being held and to register.

### Class Visits:

In accordance with our academic calendar, we are pleased to welcome candidates to Georgetown to visit our graduate business facility and to also join one of our MBA classes. To schedule a class visit, please contact the MBA-EP Office.

### Dates to Remember:

The on-line application system will be accessible beginning in Mid-October for the 2008 admission cycle.

Application deadlines for consideration for Fall 2008 admission are January 18, 2008 (Round 1) and April 11, 2008 (Round 2).

### Tuition:

MBA Evening Program tuition for the 2007-2008 academic year is \$1,100 per credit hour. The Class of 2010 will take 20 credit hours in 2007-08, for a total billed amount of \$22,000 for the year. Tuition is billed in three semester installments, based upon the number of credits per semester. Textbooks and other course materials are not included in tuition.
